SUBJECT: MICHELIN TIRE PRESSURE CHECKING RECOMMENDATIONS AND AUTOMATIC TIRE INFLATION SYSTEMS

- As a result of the inherent unique design features of wide base single tires (X one XTA, X one XTE, etc...), it is imperative that Michelin's tire pressure checking recommendations (see below) be followed to avoid over inflation that can occur when wide base single tires are used in conjunction with an automatic tire inflation system.
- Michelin recommends that tire pressure (for ALL TIRE MODELS) be MANUALLY CHECKED AT LEAST ONCE A WEEK, as stated in their Truck Tire Service Manual and Truck Tire Operator's Manual and Limited Warranty:

“Check inflation pressures on all your tires at least once a week, including spares, before driving when tires are cold, especially when vehicle is used by more than one driver.”

“The ideal time to check tire pressure is early in the morning. Driving, even a short distance, causes tires to heat up and air pressures to increase.”
